The meeting was chaired by Ms. Madhu K Garg, IAS, Secretary, SJETA, along with Dr. Tapasya Raghau, IAS, Spl. Secretary (Health), Project Director, APSACS, and representatives of the RRTC NE-II members. Shri Abou Mere the Director of Kripa Foundation, had explain about the objectives of the survey to provide national and state-level estimates of proportion and absolute number of people who use various substance and people who are suffering from substance use disorders in India.

The RRTC NE-II (Kripa Foundation) will take the lead role in the research project for the state of Arunachal Pradesh in which the survey will be conduct in the 4(four) Districts i.e. Papumpare, Tawang, Tirap and West Siang. The study will help to understand the magnitudes & proportion of population using substances and response. The research will also look into the gaps in policies and programme for drug demand and harm reduction in the state.

. After detailed deliberation in the meeting the followings recommendation were made for the effective implementation for the 'National Survey on Extent and Pattern of Substance Use"

- a. Department of SJETA, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh to give logistics support to the RRTC NE-II
- b. Spl. Secretary(Health) has advice to proposed to the Ministry, GOI, for more districts like Anjaw , Lohit which is more vulnerable area of substance use in the State of Arunachal Pradesh.
- c. RRTC NE-II, State Project Coordinator will coordinate with the Project Director, (APSACS) -cum-Nodal officer, Drug De-Addiction Cell, Directorate of Health Services, Naharlgun , Papumpare District, Arunachal Pradesh for further correspondence regarding National survey on Extent and Pattern of Substance use in the state.
